**PROCLAMATION**  
**(FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS AND SECURITIES INDUSTRY)**


I, Russell C. Weigel, III, Commissioner of the Office of Financial Regulation, by the power vested in me by sections 252.62 and 655.90, Florida Statutes, do hereby acknowledge Office of the Governor, Executive Order 25-13, concerning a Gulf Winter Weather System involving an area of low pressure moving across the Gulf of America, interacting with Artic air which will bring impactful winter weather to North Florida beginning Tuesday, January 21, 2025, likely to include snow, sleet and freezing rain which conditions are projected to constitute a major disaster, and declaring that a state of emergency exists in the State of Florida. Therefore, I authorize:

I. Impacted state, national, and federally chartered financial institutions located in North and North Central Florida to close or remain closed until the officers of such institutions advise me that the emergency conditions no longer exist.

II. Suspension of the notice-filing requirements for a securities industry dealer or investment adviser whose operations are impacted by the emergency conditions such that they plan to relocate displaced personnel to a temporary location that is not currently notice-filed as a branch office or identified as a regular non-branch location. If a registrant's staff are relocated pursuant to this Proclamation, the registrant should use its best efforts to provide written notification to the Division of Securities as soon as possible, but not later than five days after relocating. The notice should include the following information: office address, entities involved, names of registered personnel, and telephone number.
